Content

The course

- deals with academic text on a macro level from a global perspective
- deals with rhetorical structures and linguistic choices for various subjects from a local perspective
- creates a forum for continuous writing and feedback from participants and teachers

Learning Outcomes

After completing the course, the student will

- be able to critically read and write academic text
- master both content and rhetorical form of a scientific text
- be able to contribute to the department's text production
- have produced a complete draft of a journal article or equivalent.

Forms of Teaching

Teaching is conducted in the form of seminars. Language of instruction is both in English and Swedish.

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Forms of Examination

The course is examined through seminar exercises and through an article script (or equivalent) in a publishing status. The student has the right to change examiner after being rejected twice by the same examiner. A written request for exchange is submitted to the head of department.

Student rights and obligations at examination are in accordance with guidelines and rules for the University of Borås.
